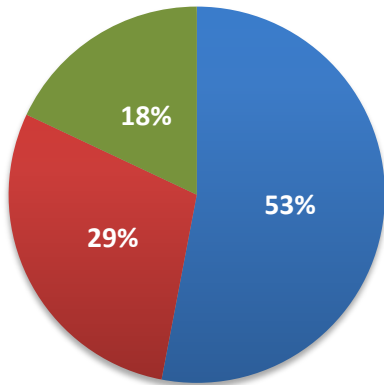


## Missourians Show Strong Support for Nuclear Power

Below are key findings from a survey conducted by Public Policy Polling, a North Carolina-based research firm, on March 24-26, 2011. The survey, commissioned by Missourians for a Balanced Energy Future, asked 652 registered voters throughout Missouri about their positions on and opinions of nuclear power use. The poll margin of error is +/-3.8%.

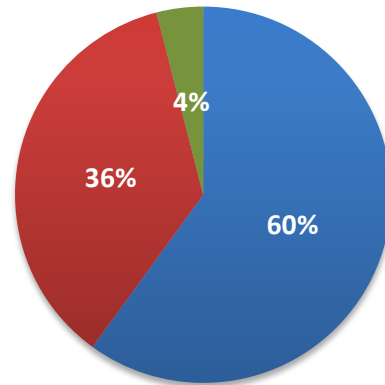

**A majority of respondents, 53%, support the use of nuclear power.**



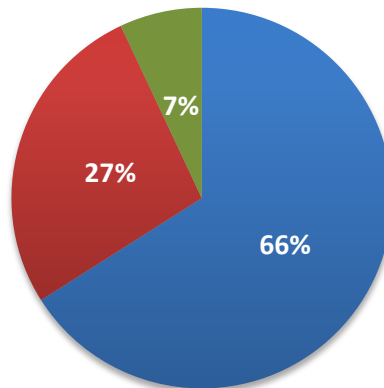
■ Support ■ Oppose ■ Not Sure
