

Missourians Show Strong Support for Nuclear Power


Below are key findings from a survey conducted by Public Policy Polling, a North Carolina-based research firm, on March 24-26, 2011. The survey, commissioned by Missourians for a Balanced Energy Future, asked 652 registered voters throughout Missouri about their positions on and opinions of nuclear power use. The poll margin of error is \pm /-3.8%.





Sixty percent of respondents favor constructing a second power plant in the state.



Missourians overwhelmingly want to keep nuclear power as an option to address the state's future energy needs - 66% believe the option should be kept open.
